

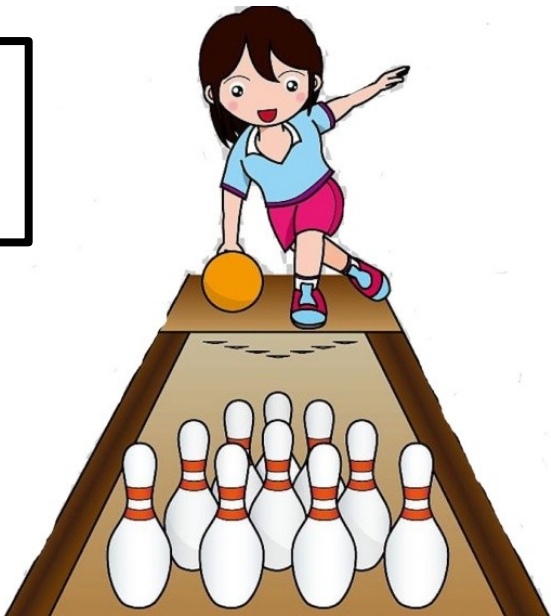

Tournament Rules

- 1) All participants must have an active membership through the Central Sonoma County USBC (CSCUSBC). Any participants who have memberships outside of CSCUSBC can pay a \$8 local fee to become members of CSCUSBC
- 2) Handicap will be 90% of the difference between the total of the two averages and 480.
- 3) You may bowl this event twice, but must have a different partner.
- 4) The competition will consist of 3 games.
- 5) **ENTERING AVERAGES** – each bowler's entering average will be based on the following averages, in the following order:
 - a) Highest USBC certified average (minimum of 21 games) for the 2023-2024 winter season OR USBC certified average (minimum of 21 games) as of October 19, 2024.
 - b) Highest USBC certified average (minimum of 21 games) for the 2024 summer season.
 - c) Highest USBC certified average (minimum of 21 games) for the 2021-2022 or 2022-2023 season (winter or summer).
 - d) If none of the above apply, the bowler will use an average of 240.
 - e) If a sport or challenge condition league average is the bowler's only verifiable average, it will be adjusted per the appropriate USBC conversion chart to determine the correct entering average.
- 6) No fees will be refunded. There will be a \$25 charge for returned checks.
- 7) **DRESS CODE** – dress appropriately for a Championship tournament. No sexual, profane, or otherwise offensive material will be allowed on any attire or equipment. No tank tops or cut-offs allowed. Tournament management shall determine the validity of any complaints.
- 8) Unsportsmanlike or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated. Improper conduct, as determined by the tournament management, may result in disqualification and cause you to forfeit your entry fee and all prize money.
- 9) The use of EZ Slide or any other such substance applied to the sole of the shoe is not allowed.
- 10) Except as altered above, all other USBC rules apply.
